



## Mount Holly Select Board In Person Meeting COVID-19 Guidelines

- To limit the contact and spread of COVID-19 it is strongly encouraged that the public access the meeting remotely if they have the capability. There will be opportunities throughout the meeting for public comment from remote attendees. Remote attendees are asked to either physically raise their hand or use “Raise Hand” button in Zoom. If you are using telephone to call in to meeting use \*9 to raise hand. We ask remote attendees to mute themselves during the meeting until their turn to speak. If they are using a telephone to call in to meeting \*6 mutes and unmutes.
- The maximum occupancy of the Town Highway Garage is 25 people;** this is based on Vermont ACCD guidance of 1 person per 100 square feet. Once occupancy is exceeded the meeting will be postponed due to safety concerns and the meeting will be rescheduled after addressing concerns.
- FACE COVERINGS MUST BE WORN** by all that attend. Please bring your own face coverings.
- Social Distancing will be required. Six foot spacing must be maintained by all. Limited seating will be provided and spaced appropriately. **DO NOT MOVE SEATS.**
- Restroom access will not be provided as we cannot ensure proper sanitization.
- Surfaces will be sanitized prior to meeting and after meeting by town staff.
- In person attendance of the meeting will be contingent on answering “**NO**” to the following questions:
  - Do you show symptoms of COVID-19, such as cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, chills, repeating shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell?
  - Have you been in close contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days? “*close contact*” is defined as anyone within 6 feet of the person for longer than 15 minutes without facial covering.
  - Do you have a fever (temperature greater than 100.4 F)?
  - Have you traveled outside of VT to areas in the northeast with a higher active case load than Vermont?  
*Northeast includes New England, NY, PA, OH, NJ DE, MD, VI, WV, DC*
  - Have you traveled outside of the northeast in past 14 days?
- In person attendance of the meeting is contingent on a temperature screening of less than 100.4<sup>0</sup> F.
