

INTRODUCTION

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The Town of Mount Holly Municipal Planning Grant Committee (MPGC) applied for and was awarded a grant from the State of Vermont Agency of Commerce and **Community Development through the Rutland Regional Planning Grant Program to** develop a Master Plan for the Village of Belmont.

This Master Plan is a document—often with photos, drawings and maps—which outline the desired future vision and specific goals of the community. It can cover a wide variety of local issues, including but not limited to housing, parking, water and sewer services, streetscape improvements, business needs, recreation, tourism, trail improvements, and many others.

To develop this Plan the MPGC conducted a **Community Vision Survey** in 2022 to identify and understand community concerns related to housing, economic development, public infrastructure and other issues. The results of that survey have been used to identify some community priorities. Tonight, we hope to discuss some of those priorities and get your feedback on potential ideas.

Using your input from this meeting, we will begin to craft a Draft Master Plan which is anticipated to be presented to the public this summer, and revised again based on public input. Our goal is to complete the plan in August so that it can enable and support the Town in pursuing grant funding to implement some of the ideas.


